The ERIS 2024 School will start next Monday. We are looking forward to welcoming you all to Granada! The School will be held at IAA-CSIC main building ([Glorieta de la Astronomía, S/N, 18008, Granada](#)), at the main lecture hall (Salón de Actos). Note that the IAA has multiple sites. Ensure you go to the correct address.

Program

The first three days of the school will feature lectures and hands-on tutorials, attended by all participants. On Thursday, we will hold parallel sessions with four separate groups, each focusing on one advanced tutorial. You have been assigned to these tutorials according to your preferences and room capacity. During ERIS, you will work in small groups to design an observational proposal with one or more instruments. On Monday, we will organise participants according to their interests in the proposed science cases and instruments. At the end of the school, each group will present their proposal ideas. Volunteers to lead these groups will be selected on the first day of the school.

WI-FI

The IAA-CSIC provides Eduroam, allowing you to access the network freely within the building. The app [geteduroam](#) is recommended to configure your connection. Use your institutional credentials to set up your Eduroam connection in your laptop, preferably before travelling.

If you encounter issues with Eduroam, you can alternatively use a Wi-Fi guest account. You will soon receive an email with the credentials sent to the email address you used for registration. Please make a note of these credentials in case you do not have internet access.

Weather forecast

Expect sunny or partially cloudy conditions, typical for this time of the year in Granada, with minimal chances of rain. Although daytime temperatures will be warm, please note that there can be a temperature variation of about 15°C between day and night.

Remember to bring closed-toe shoes, warm clothing, and comfortable attire for the visit to IRAM 30 m observatory.
